GENERAL INFORMATION ON THE REGION

The Host City – Montesilvano (Pescara - Abruzzo – Italy)



Founded around the 2nd century BC, Montesilvano experienced considerable economic prosperity thanks to the presence of the Saline, whose production was sold and sent to Rome.

Following the fall of the Roman Empire, the city was included in some fiefdoms and was subsequently incorporated into the Kingdom of Naples (15th century).

In 1815, the city was sold to the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies with the Bourbon Dynasty and in 1861 the city, along with the rest of the Region, was annexed to the Kingdom of Italy.

The arrival of the railway as early as 1863 led Montesilvano to be an economic center of freight transport; this fact would lead to heavy bombings during World War I and World War II which almost entirely destroyed the city.



The reconstruction from 1946 onwards saw the city specialize in a tourist economy, with numerous hotel and commercial settlements, and the summer exploitation of the extensive beaches which led to a real demographic explosion (7,300 inhabitants in 1951 to 54,000 in 2019).



Today the economy of the city is mainly based on the tourist offer; a 2023 estimate attests that in the summer Montesilvano received over 500.000 tourist presences.

- **Pescara “Pasquale Liberi” International Airport:** 15 km from Montesilvano, 20’ driving approx., by Highway Pescara/SS714.

- The Official UCI Montesiilvano World Cup Shuttle transfer service for athletes, staff and equipment from/to Roma-Fiumicino Airport or Pescara Airport to hotel before and after the event, as follow:
 - On 2nd-3rd-4th May, service will be provided with two trips a day:
 - Morning: shuttle starts at 10:00am
 - Afternoon: shuttle starts at 4:30pm

Large groups arriving/leaving at different times should give detailed information when booking.

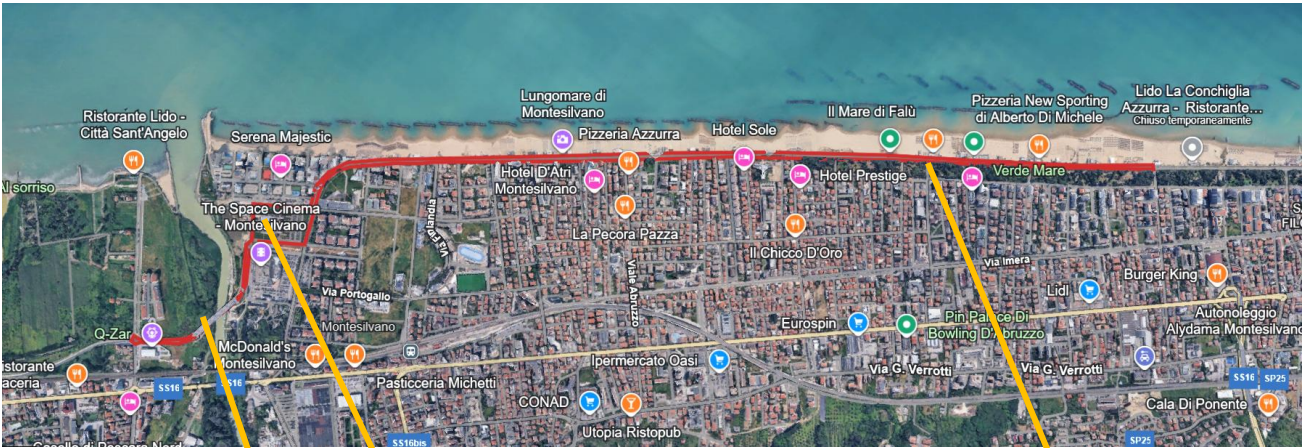

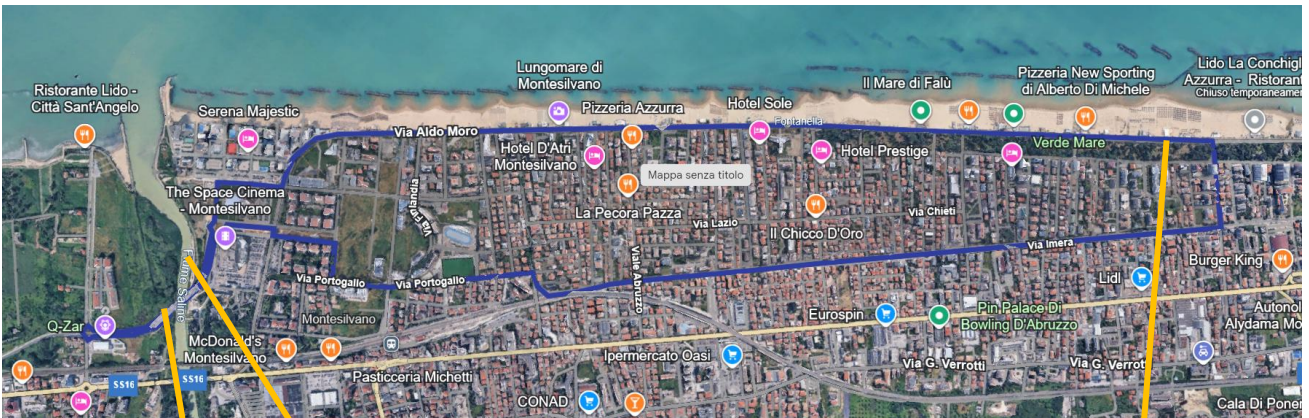

SUBMISSION OF CLASSIFICATION PAPERWORK

All athletes with a New, Review or Fixed Review Date 2026 or earlier must be present for all days of Classification to allow for scheduling.

ANTIDOPING

Antidoping station will be located at **PALA DEAN MARTIN MONTESILVANO**.

Doping Control Officers and chaperones will be on site and notify any athlete who has been selected for the doping control. Chaperones will guide selected athletes and support staff to the doping control station.

RIDERS' REGISTRATIONS

National Federations shall confirm their participation on the UCI online registration system no later than 30 March 2026 at 23:59 CET. In reference to the UCI regulations (art. 16.20.006), registration shall take place on the UCI online registration website [UCI Dataride](#).

The registration must include the number of persons making up each delegation, registration of riders in each race as well as their sport class, accommodation used during the event, full contact details of the team manager and each athlete's time of arrival.

A single representative from each National Federation shall confirm the starters of each nation, as well as whether they are participating through the national team, as individuals or for any other team under the recommendation of the National Federation.

The UCI online registration begins on 16 March 2026 at 12:00 (CET) and closes on 30 March at 23:59 (CET).

The registration fee will be € 75.00 per registration request. Refunds will not be done for athletes who did not complete the online registration. Until payments have been made, registration will not be considered as being completed. Only National Federations that have paid their registration fee within the deadline will receive an accreditation and will be able to take part in the competition. Countries need to show a **proof of payment** when picking up accreditations.

UCI and Organizing Committee will not be held responsible if you or your team miss their return flight due to delays in the program.

Registration fee must be paid in advance by 10 April.

RACE NUMBERS

Race numbers will be assigned after the confirmation of starters and distributed at the team managers' meeting. C, T, and B division athletes must wear 1 number for the individual time trial and 2 with the frame plate for the Road Race.

H class riders must wear identifying numbers (either stickers or bib numbers) on both sides and the frame plate mounted to the safety bar for individual Time Trial and Individual Road Race.

Team relay numbers will be distributed before the race starts on Sunday Morning after the specific Team Relay Meeting.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All athletes are required to use transponders.

A deposit of €50 per athlete, capped at €500 per team, is payable in cash only upon confirmation of athlete participation during the Confirmation of Starters.

Transponders will be distributed to team managers after the Team Managers Meeting on 06 May 2026.

INSURANCE

Each team is responsible for the insurance of its athletes. It is compulsory that the insurance covers: damage to property, personal injuries and/or health problems, third-party liabilities.

The Organising Committee is not responsible for any losses or damage to the material stored.

AWARD CEREMONIES

The overall UCI Para Cycling Road World Cup Champions will be determined following the road races on Saturday and Sunday.

A trophy will be given to the Champions at the end of each award ceremony; therefore, we kindly request that the athlete be made available for this event, regardless of whether they are on the podium.

MEDIA ACCREDITATIONS

The Media Accreditation will be located at Grand Hotel Adriatico.

VISAS

Each Federation is responsible for obtaining the necessary documentation for their delegation.

If necessary, the organizing committee can offer assistance by providing you with a letter of invitation that will permit you to obtain a visa from the Italian embassy of your country.

Your request must be written on official stationery of the National Federation and should be signed and stamped by the President or the Secretary. The following information must be given for each member of the delegation:

- Last and First Name
- Birth date and place
- Passport number
- UCI code
- Function (athlete, coach, physio...)
- Name of the event
- Arrival and departure dates
- The place of residence during the entire stay
- A declaration confirming that all costs for accommodation, travelling, health and expenses incurred in treating any injury, will be covered by the National Federation
